

IT'S JUST NOT WORTH IT!

The Liquor Act 2007 and other relevant Acts provide for severe penalties to patrons who break the law on licensed premises.

The following is a list of just some offences relevant to patrons & minors.

LIQUOR ACT 2007

Offence	Fine	Reference
• Supply of liquor to minor on licensed premises	\$1100	Section 117(2)
• Minor obtaining/attempting to obtain liquor to consume on premises	\$220	Section 18(1)(a)
• Minor using false evidence of age	\$220	Section 129
• Minor enter/remain in minors authorization area unaccompanied	\$220	Section 124 (1)(6)
• Obtain liquor on behalf of a minor	\$1100	Section 117(6)
• Permit minor to consume alcohol on premises	\$330	Section 120(1)
• Minor enter/remain in bar area	\$220	Section 123
• Excluded person re-enter/attempt to re-enter premises	\$550	Section 77(6)
• Excluded person fail to leave licensed premises	\$550	Section 77(4)
• Supply liquor to intoxicated person	\$550	Section 73(3)
• Excluded person remain in/re-enter vicinity (within 50 metres of premises)	\$550	Section 77(8)
• Refuse or fail to state full name, address & date of birth	\$220	Section 128(2)(9)
